1) Program Descriptions

A. ONO Account Notifications (Transactional): One-time and recurring texts related to your account and use of ONO. B. ONO Offers & Updates (Marketing): Promotional texts about features, events, discounts, and offers. C. ONO 2FA (Two-Factor Authentication): Text messages or voice calls containing security verification codes. D. ONO Call Notifications: Outbound automated or agent-assisted calls for account verification, fraud prevention, or urgent service updates.

2) Enrollment & Consent

By providing your number, you consent to receive SMS, MMS, 2FA verification codes, and outbound calls. Marketing requires prior express written consent. Consent is not a condition of purchase. You may opt in via app, website, or SMS keyword.

3) Message and Call Frequency

Account & 2FA: As needed by your account activity. Offers & Updates: Up to 4 messages per month (unless otherwise stated). Calls: Only for authentication or critical service updates.

4) Costs

Message, data, and call rates may apply. Check your carrier plan.

5) Opt-Out

Text STOP to cancel SMS/MMS. Supported commands include STOP, STOPALL, UNSUBSCRIBE, CANCEL, END, QUIT, REVOKE, OPTOUT. For calls, contact support to revoke consent. After opt-out, you may still receive legally mandated notifications.

6) Help

Text HELP for assistance. Contact support via support@omnioppx.com or call (555) 123-4567.

7) Supported Carriers & Delivery

Carriers are not liable for delayed or undelivered messages or calls.

8) Eligibility

You must be 18 years or older to enroll.

9) Responsibilities

You agree to update us if your number changes.

10) Privacy

12) Content Restrictions
